PeaceBugle is an international music and film project by Steve Chettle. Its key objective is to promote and support international peace. It is a response to 20th and 21st century war, civil conflict and genocide.

Within the main project, a new bugle call titled *FirstPeace* has been created by internationally acclaimed composer Sally Beamish. The brief was for a new bugle call with a duration of one minute. (To mirror one-minute silences). *FirstPeace* is a call to peace. It is a practical tool to be used to promote peace; and a musical symbol and emblem for peace activities. It is also a core part of the proposed *PeaceBugle* Audio-Visual Installation.
